In ELA this week, students edited, revised, and shared their choose your own adventure stories! Be sure to ask them to share their story with you. In math this week, students reviewed for their NC Check In. Next week, we will focus on comparing fractions using a variety of strategies and learn how benchmark fractions can help us to compare fractions.
